

Dr. Hee Soo LEE is currently Chair Professor in the Department of Cultural Anthropology of Hanyang University, the Director of Sungkonghoe Institute for Islamic Studies and Visiting Professor at Keimyung University, Korea. A well-known anthropologist of Middle Eastern studies in Korea, he completed his BA and MA degrees at Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, Seoul and Ph.D. at the Istanbul University. He has conducted extensive field works in many Muslim countries including Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, Egypt, Iran, Malaysia and the Uzbekistan since 1979. He had served as the president of the Korean Association of Middle East Studies from 2008 to 2009 and director of Korea Institute of Islamic Culture. He researched at the University of Washington in 2002 and 2012, and University of Vienna in 2014 as a visiting professor. In addition, he serves as the Secretary General of the Korea-Turkey Friendship Association. Currently he is a leading advisor to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Counter-Terrorism Center and National Police Agency of the Korean government. He has authored 82 books on Islamic Studies and Middle East in Korean, English, Turkish and Arabic.
